AOF FILM FEST COURTS INDIE “EXPLORING LOVE” BY BESTOWING BEST DRAMA FEATURE NOM

Miami – July 3, 2008—Director/Producer Brent Bambic’s latest film “Exploring Love,” which speaks to the universal theme of finding personal happiness, has received nominations for Best Drama Feature and Outstanding Cast Performance by the AOF (Action on Film) International Film Festival. The acclaimed film festival, founded by filmmaker Del Weston, will be held at the prestigious Laemmle’s One Colorado Theatre in Old Town Pasadena, and “Exploring Love” will have its Los Angeles premiere on Monday, July 28, 2008 at 10pm. Bambic’s first feature “Runaways”, starring Austin O’Brien, which also had its world premiere at a Cannes Film Festival, deals with the issue of runaway kids struggling to stay off the streets of Los Angeles. Now Bambic addresses the issue of feelings of emptiness as experienced by Sean Parker, a successful young man running a talent agency in South Beach.

Rising stars Matthew Pearson, JeanPaul SanPedro, Kristia Knowles, Katherine Newcomer and Ashley Noel light up the screen in this sexy-spiritual movie that chronicles a slice of the life of a single man living a lifestyle desired by many but who discovers that his materialistic lifestyle has left him unfulfilled. After a few empty love affairs and some deep soul searching Sean discovers where the answer to happiness lies.

The up-and-coming filmmaker shot “Exploring Love” on HD to capture the hip international vibe of Miami and he used many upscale locations to highlight its glamour and excitement, but only as a backdrop to the very real story of a young man who strives to find true fulfillment. In truth, this story could take place almost anywhere.

Bambic, who also wrote the script, wanted to deal with real life issues that people can relate to. The indie director says, “We’re taught that enlightenment or a state of grace is achieved through judgment, but this actually causes us to be preoccupied with what we judge, such as sexuality, which is self-destructive... When we still our mind that’s when we hear God’s voice.”
